

Ozlip – the word game for Aussies



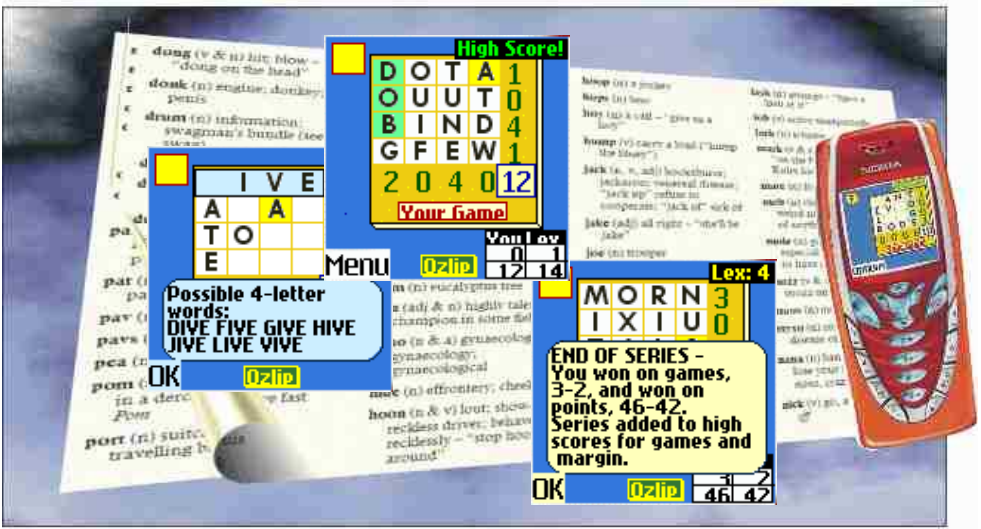
